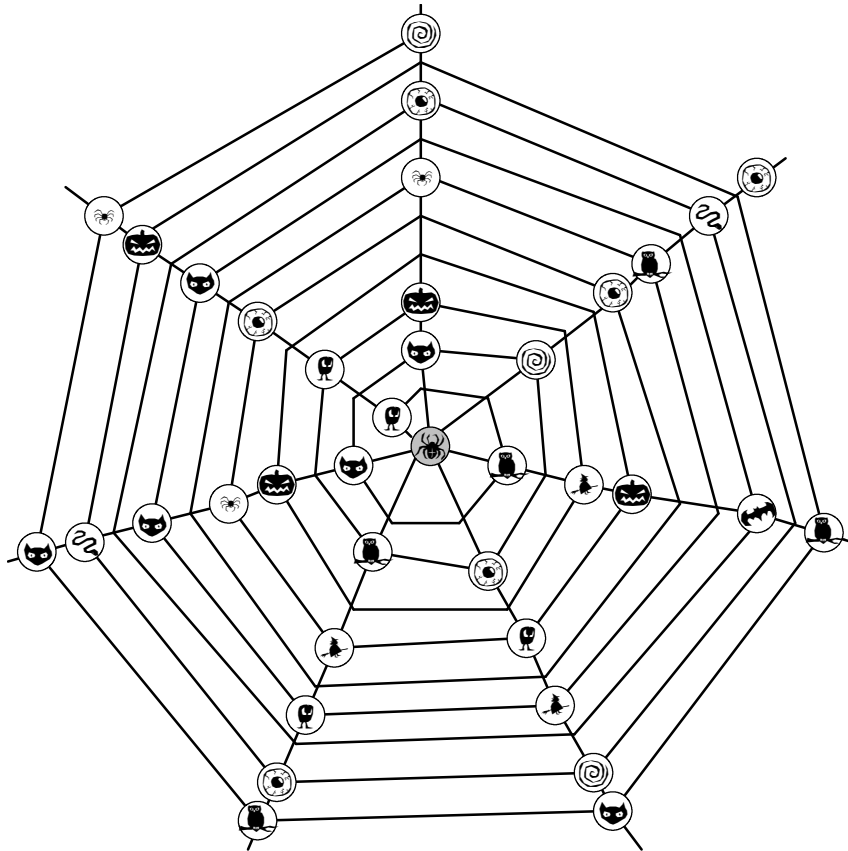


The Spider's Web
